Notice of a Proposed Construction Permit Warranting Public Comment

Notice is hereby given that an application for a proposed project or activity has been submitted to the Colorado Air Pollution Control Division for the following source of air pollution:

Applicant: EdgeConneX, Inc.

Facility: Denver Campus

The proposed project or activity is as follows:

The applicant proposes a second building at the Denver campus and installing nineteen (19) new diesel-fired emergency engines. Fifteen (15) of the nineteen (19) engines will have selective catalytic reduction to control NOx emissions. This will be a facility-wide permit also containing the existing eight (8) diesel-fired engines at the first building.

The division has determined that this permitting action is subject to public comment requirements under Colorado Air Quality Control Commission Regulation Number 3, Part B, Section III.C due to the following reason(s):

- This source is requesting a federally-enforceable limit on the potential to emit to avoid other requirements. (Regulation Number 3, Part B, Section III.C.1.d.)

The division has made a preliminary determination of approval of the application.
